The **Thames Explorer Trust** has a River Dipping Session at 11 am, which is a guided exploration of the foreshore. **The RNLI** will have information about its work, and souvenir stall. **The Sea Cadets** will have a stall where little ones can practice catching plastic ducks, and adults and children can enter a tombola. You can find out the sort of activities and training the Sea Cadets offer young people, and meet some of the current recruits.
