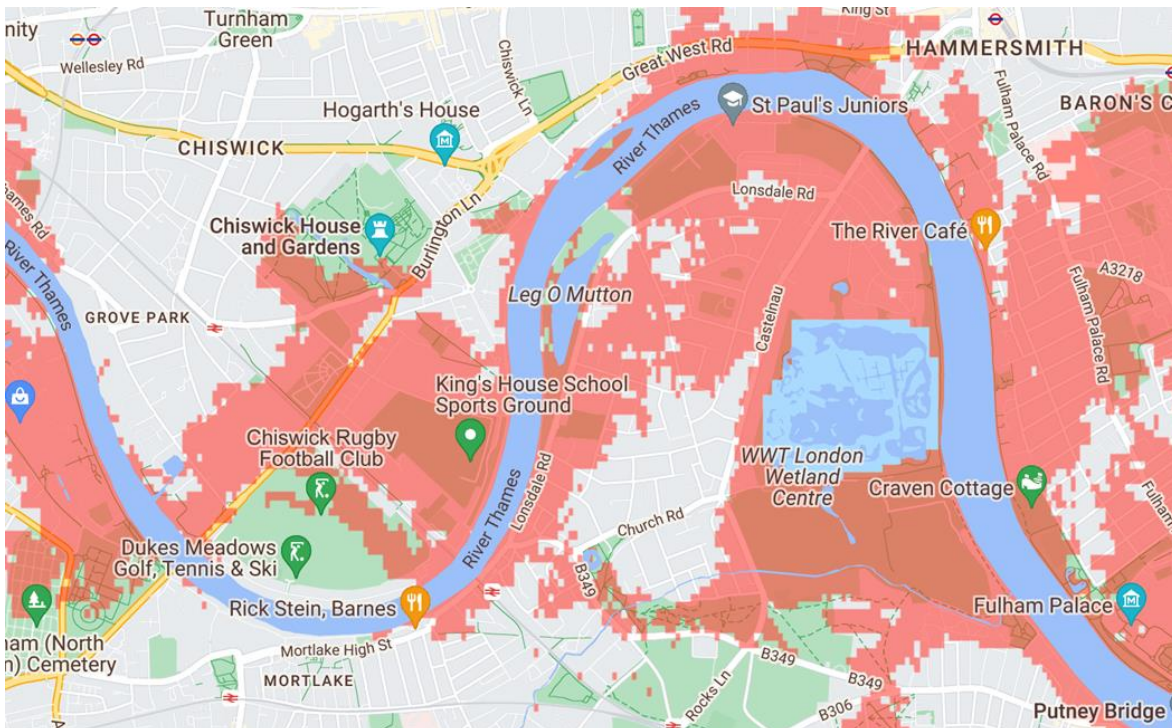




**Hello!**
